

Health insurance is not included in the program fee. The purchase of travelers' health insurance prior to departure to Korea that is valid for the entire duration of travel is the responsibility of each participant and is strongly recommended.

In the event of cancellation, the participants must notify the Office of International Affairs(OIA) in writing.

1. For any cancellation after May 31, 2017, 20% of total program fee will be retained by OIA. 2. For any cancellation after the program starts, there will be no refund. 3. Participants will not be able to change the course(s) after May 31, 2017.

It is participant's own responsibility to check with their country and embassy if visa is required to enter Korea. Participants who need a visa will have to make their own arrangements in applying for the visa prior to their arrival here in Korea.

Korean Language

This is an Elementary Korean language course. It is designed for those who have no prior (or very limited) knowledge in Korean.

The course goal is to provide a basic foundation that will enable students to acquire and develop language skills in listening, speaking, reading, and writing in Korean. Throughout the process of learning these skills, emphasis will be on the student's ability to perform in real-life situations through task-based practice.

Korean Culture

This is an introductory course to Korean culture with a focus on contemporary Korean culture. The course will explore diverse themes relevant to understanding Korea today, such as lifestyles(meeting friends, shopping, etc.). In doing so, the course analyzes various mediums such as historical texts, material objects, photographs, geography, literature, films, and newspaper articles.

Introduction to Sailing Yacht

This course is to give a broad understanding of sailing yacht. It is designed to give students to understand basic concepts in sailing. Students who successfully complete this course should be able to achieve knowledge of different types of knots and boats, parts of a yacht as well as the history and theory of sailing. This course will be conducted in the classroom(1st week) and on the beach(2nd and 3rd week).

Understanding of International Relations

This is an introductory course on International Relations theories and methods. This course provides an overview of the activities, participants, and politics involved in International Relations at the state and local levels.

Topics of discussion include: International Relations as a social science. Theories of International Relations, Actors involved in International Relations, History of International Relations.

By the end of the course, students should be conversant in basic IR theory and have the intellectual equipment to understand, criticize, and apply these (and other) theories of international relations. The course is also designed to provide students with an understanding of the potential and limitations of theory in the study of international politics.
