- Conduct research on the synthesis, characterization, and application of polymers within the framework of the AEI PID2020-113264RB-11 project, titled "Design, synthesis, and characterization of smart polymers. Application of polymeric chemical sensors in food control and safety and in the healthcare field (SmartPolySensor)." Specifically, the focus will be on designing and preparing polymeric materials for the visual detection of biomolecules and species of food interest (food safety and quality control) as well as species, enzymes/biomarkers of medical interest (human health applications).
- Train and supervise doctoral students within the scope of the research project PID2020-113264RB-11.
- Collaborate in the drafting of research projects at regional, national, and European levels.
- Oversee the preparation and presentation of research projects.
