Application Link – Nominated students will receive an email with a link to apply. 3. Online Application – Complete the application, including campus housing selection. 4. Visa Documents – Receive necessary documents for a visa, including the admission letter. 5. Pre-arrival Requirements – Complete course registration and dormitory payment before arrival. <p>Required Documents for Application</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identification photo (color, 3.5cm * 4.5cm) (headshot, front view on white background) 2. A color copy of the passport 3. Academic transcript (English) 4. Letter of recommendation (English) 5. A self-medical checkup form 6. Agreement on personal information 7. Certificate of enrollment (Apostilled, original copy) 8. Bank balance certificate – At least 4,500,000 KRW deposited (Apostilled, original copy) <p>* If applicable, other certificates such as language, activities, etc.</p> <p>Note</p> <p>- Number 7 and 8 documents are exclusively for students based on nationality from non-OECD member countries. Please provide the original copy via international post.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Visa Process</p>	<p>Please contact the embassy in your country for details, as the process may vary among countries.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Keimyung will issue and send the certificate of admission. - Generally, each student needs to submit the documents

	<p>listed below to the Korean Embassy in their country.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Valid Passport (validity of <u>at least 6 months</u>) b. Certificate of admission c. Business registration of the host university d. Completed visa application form e. Recent certificate of school record f. Verification of bank account balance g. Visa processing fee
<p>Courses / English Language Proficiency</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exchange students typically enroll in the courses offered in English. Therefore, an intermediate/high level of English proficiency is required to take these courses. - Certificates (e.g., TOEFL / IELTS) are not required. - Students may choose to register for the courses offered in Korean. However, an intermediate/high level of Korean proficiency is required to take these courses.
<p>Health Insurance</p>	<p>Compulsory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All international students are required to have national insurance from the Republic of Korea (approximately \$70 per month). They will be automatically and compulsorily enrolled when they apply for their alien registration card. <p>Optional</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students may individually purchase additional traveler's insurance.
<p>Housing</p>	<p>Dormitory application</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students can apply for a dormitory when submitting the online application form. - All students are guaranteed campus housing if they apply during the online application period. <p>Dormitory Fee (As of Spring 2025 Semester)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - General Hall (2 persons/room) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,524,000 b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,125,000

- c. Without meal: KRW 641,000
- Bongsu (male only) / Hyupruk Hall (female only)
(2 persons/room)
 - a. With two meals a day: KRW 2,131,000
 - b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,732,000
 - c. Without meal: KRW 1,248,000
- Please note that the above information is for reference only, and dormitory fees may vary each semester.
