Student Eligibility for Bilateral Exchange	Nominated students must meet all of the requirements: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In good academic standing (Undergraduate Students: 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale) (Graduate Students: 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale); 2. Will continue degree program at partner university, after exchange at SJSU; 3. English Language Proficiency.

Application Deadlines	<p>Fall semester/Academic Year: March 15th Spring semester: September 30th SJSU Bilateral Exchange Application and supporting documents must be submitted by the deadline. ISSS will email partners the application link to send to students. *Applications received after these deadlines may not be accepted.</p>

Majors	<p>Nominated students will need to submit their intended major during their exchange program on the exchange application. They will need to look at the list of Undergraduate majors.</p> <p>Impacted majors at SJSU are: Animation and Illustration, Biological Sciences – Marine Biology, Computer Science, Computer Science and Linguistics, Data Science, Graphic Design, and Engineering (Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Materials Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Software Engineering), Nursing.</p> <p>*We cannot take nominations for exchange for students in these majors.</p>
Health Insurance	<p>All J-1 exchange students are required to purchase the SJSU approved University health insurance plan through JCB Insurance Services. More information about health insurance will be sent to accepted students.</p>

<p>Internships and Employment</p>	<p>Under SJSU's J-1 Exchange Visitor student visa program, J-1 students may be authorized to work up to 20 hours a week on-campus during their studies at SJSU (on-campus employment). Full time after their studies end, for a period not to exceed the length of their exchange program (Academic Training).</p> <p>On-campus employment is an employment benefit for students in J-1 visa status. Students need authorization from ISSS before they start working. More information will be given to students at the Orientation/Arrival Program.</p> <p>Academic Training is an employment authorization directly related to an exchange student's program of study at SJSU. To qualify, the student must be in good academic standing, maintain full time enrollment and have a job offer. Students interested in Academic Training should see a J-1 advisor for more information about employment authorizations after arrival at SJSU.</p>
