Language requirements for international students	B1 or B2 Italian (according to the requirements of the study course). Any certificate can be accepted, also certificates from the home university stating that the student has the requested level.
Academic fulfilments for international students	On their arrival, students must go first to the assigned Department and meet the Departmental International Coordinator, who will provide them with information about courses, lectures and subjects agreed in the Learning Agreement.
	Students then have one month, from their arrival, to work the changes in their Learning Agreement. All the changes to Learning Agreement must be approved first by your home Institution, and then by Host Institution (UniME).
	Before enrolling at the exams, International students have to do a compulsory registration for each exam by ESSE3, the operating system that manages students' career at UniME.
	Students must not take examinations without booking by ESSE3 or sit for examinations that are not included in their Learning Agreement.

Italian Language courses	The Department of Ancient and Modern Civilizations (DICAM) provides free courses of Italian language for Erasmus+ students. Elementary and intermediate level courses are organized throughout the two semesters of the academic year.
	The attendance of the 40-hour long course allows students to get 2 credits (reported in the transcript of records) and the Certificate of Attendance. Please note that the total number of absences allowed is 25% of the total hours of lessons.

	the University must be sent to the ERSU (Regional Agency for the right



	to Higher Education) well in advance, before the start of the academic
	year, to allow scheduling of arrivals and booking of rooms. Since the number of rooms for foreign students and visitors is limited, assignment of rooms is subject to availability.
	The Welcome Office will assist you in the booking procedure. Living in a student residence hall provides students with a good living situation, close to other students, as well as being near the University.
