### ERASMUS DEADLINES AND PROCEDURES

The home University has to send an email to [rapp.int@jus.unipi.it](mailto:rapp.int@jus.unipi.it) with the following student's information:

Then the University of Pisa Law Department will notify students if they have been accepted and send them instructions on how to apply to the University of Pisa and submit the application, through our Erasmus Mobility portal.

**Deadlines for nomination:**

Fall/Winter Semester or Annual: **May 30<sup>th</sup>**  
Spring/Summer Semester: **October 15<sup>th</sup>**

**Deadlines for application:**

Fall/Winter Semester or Annual: **June 30<sup>th</sup>**  
Spring/Summer Semester: **November 15<sup>th</sup>**

### ENROLMENT PROCEDURE FOR Erasmus Incoming students

The deadlines are not mandatory, but it is recommended to meet them because we need to approve the Learning Agreements before the summer.

**Step One:** Register on ALICE ([here's how to do it](#)).

**Step Two:** Fill out the application form on the Erasmus Mobility Portal ([here's how to do it](#))

**Step Three:** Prepare your Learning Agreement and upload it to the portal. You will be able to choose your subjects from our courses of study.

When our Erasmus coordinator approves the Learning Agreement, the student will be matriculated at our University and can complete the procedure by requesting an appointment through the portal, to pick up the student card when he/she arrives in Pisa in September.

## LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION and LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

Courses are taught in Italian and all exams are oral.

**An Italian language certificate is not mandatory, but a B1 in ITALIAN level is highly recommended.**

Courses of Italian language are available for free for all Erasmus students, at the **CLI (Linguistic Center) – AREA INTERNAZIONALE**

Further courses in English will be held in the second semester within the program EMILDAI (European Master in Law, Data and Artificial Intelligence), and their attendance is limited to students with at least a B1 level in English:

**EMILDAI \*(European Master in Law, Data and Artificial Intelligence):**

- 1) Comparative Law of AI and New Technologies (6 ECTS)
- 2) Blockchain, Cryptocurrencies, and AI (6 ECTS)
- 3) Law and Ethics of AI (9 ECTS)
- 4) Internship and dissertation (9 ECTS)

*\*The EMILDAI Module will start in the 2nd semester of A.Y. 2023-2024.*
