<b>Application process</b>	<p><b>The deadlines for the application are:</b></p> <p><b>July 31<sup>st</sup></b> (for mobility in the I Semester or for the whole year) <b>December 15<sup>th</sup></b> (for mobility in the II Semester)</p> <p><b><u>The application steps:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Register on the <b>ALICE Portal</b> to obtain a username and password: <a href="https://www.studenti.unipi.it/AddressBook/ABStartProcessoRegAction.do">https://www.studenti.unipi.it/AddressBook/ABStartProcessoRegAction.do</a></li> <li>2. Using the ALICE username and password, access the Erasmus Organizer portal and fill the application form.</li> <li>3. Upload your Learning Agreement Before Mobility, and wait for us to accept it.</li> </ol>
<b>Transcript of Records – AFTER the Mobility</b>	<p>As soon as you have finished your exams, you have to download the ECTS Transcript at ALICE Portal and send it to <a href="mailto:rapp.int@jus.unipi.it">rapp.int@jus.unipi.it</a> to have it signed by our Erasmus Coordinator. <a href="https://www.studenti.unipi.it/Home.do">https://www.studenti.unipi.it/Home.do</a> Then you can come to International Office at the department to pick up the signed copy of your ECTS Transcript. A pdf copy will also be emailed to your home university.</p>
