- Transcripts of records of the courses passed at their university.
- English B2 CEFR certificate if willing to study in English.
- •Italian B1 CEFR certificate if willing to study in Italian.
- Photocopy of valid Passport or ID.
- Current health certificate.
- Health insurance card and/or health insurance plan.

The Letter of Acceptance will be sent by email.
