Application process

- 1. Nominated students must fill out the online application form available <u>at this link</u> making sure to carefully read the necessary instructions and to upload the required documents:
- Official transcript of records in English
- Language certification (see Recommended Language requirements section)
- Valid passport or European ID
- Valid health insurance (European Health Card or equivalent)
- 2. An email notification is sent to the student after the application submission.
- 3. The Acceptance letter and information about arrivals will be sent by the International Mobility Office about two months after receiving the Erasmus Application
