Induction & Orientation: Winter Semester (teaching): Christmas holidays: Examination period:	2 Welcome Days in September / January mid-September to mid-December mid-December to 02 January 1 st two weeks of January
Spring Semester (teaching): Examination period:	Late January - mid-May, 2-week break at Easter Middle 2 weeks of May

Application procedures:	Forms sent to in-coming students after they have been nominated by their university.
Application deadlines: DO adhere to deadlines	June 1 st (for arrival in September) November 1 st (for arrival in February)
