Residence Fees	On campus housing: 593,600 KRW to 1,250,800 KRW per semester (16 weeks) ※ not compulsory to live on campus Average off campus housing rates are between 400,000 KRW and 500,000 KRW per month (two bedrooms).
Health Insurance	All students are required to be enrolled in and charged for the National Health Insurance Service. = 57,540 KRW per month
Living Cost	Meals and other living expenses Residents living on campus accommodation are required to purchase a meal (Plan A: 3,300 KRW per meal, Plan B: 3,500 KRW per meal).
