## 1. Basic information

30 June 2022 - applications for fall/winter semester or entire academic year

15 December 2022 - applications for spring/summer semester

## 2. Requirements

### 2.1 Nomination

All students must be nominated by Erasmus+ coordinator from their sending institution by e-mail (e-mails: [binio@eti.pg.edu.pl](mailto:binio@eti.pg.edu.pl), [pauszume@pg.edu.pl](mailto:pauszume@pg.edu.pl))

### 2.2 On-line registration

Students applying for exchange must fill out *application form* using on-line registration system: [moja.pg.edu.pl](http://moja.pg.edu.pl) >> Applications >> Erasmus

### 2.3 Documents

The following documents are required:

- learning agreement for studies signed by Student and Erasmus coordinator at sending institution,
- transcript of records,
- a copy of certificate confirming fluency in English at B1 level (certificates issued by Language Centre at universities are accepted)

In order to avoid problems related to frequent changes in programs of studies, please send your learning agreement to be validated (e-mail: [binio@eti.pg.edu.pl](mailto:binio@eti.pg.edu.pl))

In this situation we work on scans of learning agreements duly signed.

However, we prefer paper versions of documents with original signatures of Students and Erasmus coordinators as well as original stamps of institutions, so please bring such documents with you when you arrive.
