SAINT JAMES WAY, FROM THE PAST TO NOW

The province of Burgos is one of the main stops on the Road to Santiago in the Iberian Peninsula. Its strategic geographical situation made it a necessary path for millions of European pilgrims who came from their countries of origin in the search of the tomb of the Apostle Santiago.

Throughout the 114 kilometers that crosses its territory, astonishing displays of heritage come one after another, as well as an unmatched natural beauty, in which alternate plains, mountains, valleys and moors, which has deserved being declared a site of **World Heritage** by UNESCO.

Every village, which is crossed by the 114 kilometers from the French Road to Santiago through Burgos province, maintains its past trace. **Redecilla del Camino, Belorado, Villafranca Montes de Oca, San Juan de Ortega**, la ciudad de **Burgos, San Antón y Castrojeriz** are the main landmarks.
